Dear Mr. Webster.:

On March 16, 2017, PECO Energy Company (PECO or the Company) filed the results of its Request for Proposals (RFP) Process and Rules for the March 2017 Solicitation for provider of last resort service. The filing includes bid results for a Full Requirements RFP for Residential and Small Commercial customers who receive default service from PECO during the period June 1, 2017, through May 31, 2019. The filing also includes proposed bid results for a Full Requirements RFP for Consolidated Large Commercial and Industrial customers who receive default service from PECO during the period June 1, 2017, through May 31, 2018.

This filing was submitted in accordance with the RFP Process and Rules filed by PECO on July 28, 2016, as part of a Joint Petition for Partial Settlement. The RFP Process and Rules were approved as modified by the Partial Settlement in the Commission's Opinion and Order, entered December 8, 2016, at Docket No. P-2016-2534980.

PECO requests that the Commission approve the bid results of the March 2017 Solicitation on or before March 17, 2017.

Further investigation does not appear to be warranted at this time, since the results of the March 2017 Solicitation appear to have been conducted in accordance with the RFP Process and Rules as approved by the Commission.

Therefore, we direct PECO to disclose the results of this March 2017 Solicitation in accordance with the Commission's Secretarial Letter in <u>Re: Disclosure of Default Service Solicitation Results and Creation</u> of a Default Service Rate Calculation Model, issued October 12, 2010 at Docket No. M-2009-2082042.
